Joint international technical assistance projects:

1. Building Electoral Preparedness and Resilience Together (BEPART) 2025–2027

Funded by the European Union

The project supports the implementation of measures envisaged by the Roadmap on the Functioning of Democratic Institutions in Ukraine. It aims to enhance the efficiency, transparency and inclusiveness of electoral and referendum processes in Ukraine by improving their legal and procedural frameworks, strengthening the professional capacity of representatives of the Central Election Commission, increasing the legal awareness of electoral stakeholders and promoting international cooperation in the field of election administration.

2. Advancing Integrity in Resilient Elections (AIRE) 2025–2026

Funded by the Government of Ireland through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade of Ireland

The project supports the enhancement of the Central Election Commission's institutional capacity through the modernisation and strengthening of its information and communication systems and cybersecurity. This includes targeted procurement of equipment and software.

3. Pluralistic and Credible Elections in Ukraine (PACE) (Component II) 2026

Funded by the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden through the Swedish International Development Agency

The project supports the enhancement of the Central Election Commission's institutional capacity in the area of public and strategic communications. In particular, it provides for strengthening the professional capacity of CEC staff, supporting public information campaigns, upgrading the CEC's official website and modernising technical tools used to inform the public.
